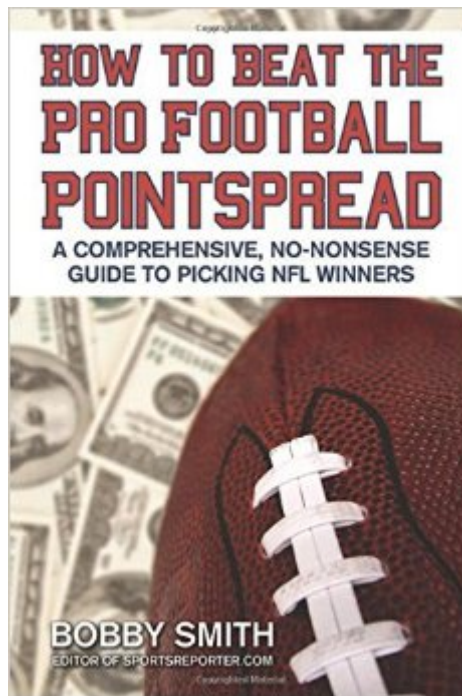

In 1993, J.R. Miller wrote the groundbreaking *How Professional Gamblers Beat the Pro Football Pointsread: A Step by Step Textbook Guide* (ISBN 0963650009, 9780963650009). On the cover, Miller describes his book as a "no-nonsense, straight-forward and thoroughly explained guide." In 2006, Bobby Smith wrote *How to Beat the Pro Football Pointsread: A Comprehensive, No-Nonsense Guide to Picking NFL Winners* (Skyhorse Publishing, Inc.). Not only is this a bad book, but it exposes another plagiarist who fails to recognize that books should be original. This book is illegal and amounts to nothing more than literary identity theft. In 2015, just one year after Miller died, Skyhorse Publishing and Smith released their 2nd Edition *How to Beat the Pro Football Pointsread: A Comprehensive, No-Nonsense Guide to Picking NFL Winners*. Really? J.R. Miller's son, J.V. Miller, who now owns the copyright, is suing Skyhorse and Smith, seeking a Cease and Desist order as well as a demand for payment for damages of \$1 million.

A lot of information that is useful but it doesn't hold you by the hand. It gives you examples and you have to do the rest.

The title makes it seem great, but it's not so much. The author comes off as pompous and arrogant and quotes statistics nonstop. Then tells you that this statistic he used is great, but the one that you used is meaningless. Yet both of them come from the same source and cover the same games and are both accurate. Could've been written a bit clearer, it's more like a critical essay, criticizing everything. Yet it is not offering any real suggestions on how to win.

This book is definitely full of breakdowns of how to predict pointsreads, what advice to ignore, etc. My only problem with this book is that the writer doesn't give definitions of all the initials (ncr, bc, etc.) Other than that, I really like the book!!
